

**Special City Council Meeting
Jackson, Minnesota
April 26, 2016**

The Jackson City Council met in special session in the Council Chambers of City Hall at 12:00 p.m. on Tuesday, April 26, 2016 with the meeting called to order by Mayor Wayne Walter. On the roll call, the following persons were present: Mayor Wayne Walter, Aldermen Handevidt, Temple, Schoenrock and Cushman and City Clerk/Council Secretary Dave Maschoff. (A quorum of the City Council was present.) (Aldermen Fred Bern, Brandon Finck and City Administrator Jennifer Bromeland were absent.)

TEMPORARY LIQUOR LICENSE REQUEST: APPROVE A ONE DAY TEMPORARY LIQUOR LICENSE FOR THE RHYTHM OF THE RIVER ORGANIZATION FOR THE GIRLS NIGHT OUT EVENT ON MAY 3, 2016 FROM 4 P.M. TO 8 P.M. AT THE JACKSON NATIONAL GUARD ARMORY

Cushman asked if the Rhythm of the River Organization was agreeable to be the non-profit host organization for Bridget Kolander-Gilbert of Bridget's Buck Snorts Brew Ha-Ha and Grill in order to obtain a one day temporary liquor license for the Girls' Night Out Event on May 3rd. He also asked if granting the temporary license would put the City in any harm's way regarding liability.

Maschoff said Kolander-Gilbert had contacted Paul Jones of the Rhythm of the River Organization and the liability insurance coverage will be similar to the coverage for Rhythm of the River. Maschoff said Kolander-Gilbert will be providing a Certificate of Insurance to the National Guard Armory and also to the City.

SCHOENROCK/TEMPLE moved and it was unanimously carried to approve a Temporary One Day Liquor License for the Rhythm of the River Organization for the Girls Night Out Event on May 3, 2016 from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. at the Jackson National Guard Armory.
