

LIQUOR COMMITTEE MEETING
January 29, 2018

A regular meeting of the City of Jackson Liquor Committee was held on January 29, 2018 at 5:15 P.M. in the Council Chambers at City Hall with the following persons in attendance: Liquor Committee member Brandon Finck, Liquor Store Manager Michelle Bratrud, Interim City Administrator Richard Almich, Architect Dustin Tomoson with Ringdahl Architects and Recording Secretary Dave Maschoff. (Liquor Committee members Dave Cushman and Matt Madden were absent.)

DUSTIN TOMOSON WITH RINGDAHL ARCHITECTS WITH INTERIOR AND EXTERIOR BUILDING SAMPLES

Architect Dustin Tomoson said he wanted to again review the floor plan and interior and exterior finishes for the proposed new liquor store. Tomoson pointed out revisions that he made to the floor plan following the Liquor Committee's January 23, 2018 meeting.

Bratrud noted there was a desire to have three long windows on both sides of the main entrance to the building.

Tomoson pointed out aspects of the floor plan and ceiling of the proposed store.

Discussion ensued regarding the floor plan and the location of the wine cooler and positioning of the shelving in the wine area.

Tomoson then had those attending the meeting look at and discuss samples he brought of various flooring types for the main part of the store, the restrooms and vestibule area. He also provided samples of finishes for the doors, windows and countertops for the building.

Liquor Committee members also reviewed various samples of exterior finishes.

Those attending the meeting chose potential floor coverings along with interior and exterior finishes, wood trim and paint colors for the main portion and restrooms. They also looked at the color of the shingles for the building.

Tomoson compiled notes of the comments made regarding finishes. Tomoson said he would take the colors and finishes suggested and put together the interior model and renditions for the Liquor Committee to review and suggest any further modifications. He said he can also develop a 3-D model of the proposed building for review.

Tomoson said he would have the people involved with shelving meet with Bratrud.

Tomoson was thanked for attending and bringing interior and exterior building samples to the Liquor Committee meeting.

With no further business, the Liquor Committee meeting was adjourned.
