**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING FEES, RATES & CHARGES FOR 2023**

**THE CITY OF JACKSON ORDAINS** as follows:

**Section 1.** The City of Jackson, Minnesota, hereby adopts – and may impose and collect – fees, rates, and charges for City services or permits according to the following schedule:
